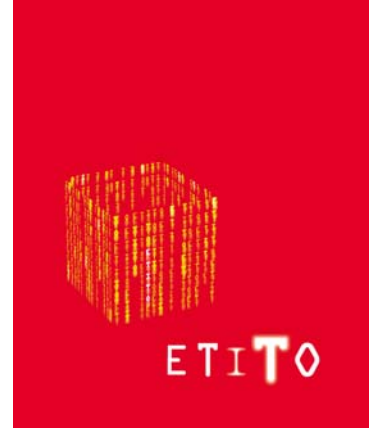


ETITO's assessor workshop kicks off with a bang!
